**STANDING ORDER DISCONTINUING
THE IMPOSITION OF CIVIL
ASSESSMENTS UPON FAILURE TO
APPEAR OR FAILURE TO PAY**

Pursuant to AB 199, effective July 1, 2022, the maximum civil assessment that can be imposed for a failure to appear or failure to pay was reduced from \$300 to \$100. All outstanding civil assessment debt as of June 30, 2022 was rendered unenforceable and uncollectable. Effective July 1, 2022, the Siskiyou County Superior Court began imposing civil assessments at the reduced rate of \$100 as authorized by Penal Code section 1214.1.

THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS: Effective November 1, 2023, the Siskiyou County Superior Court shall discontinue imposing civil assessments pursuant to Penal Code section 1214.1 in each eligible case in which a defendant has failed to appear or failed to pay. All outstanding debt from civil assessments imposed between July 1, 2022 and November 1, 2023 is hereby vacated and shall be stricken. Notwithstanding this order, judicial officers retain discretion to impose civil assessments, subject to Penal Code section 1214.1 and other applicable law.
